Governor Abbott has announced the lifting of the state-wide mask mandate effective Wednesday 3/10/21. AquaKids will continue to monitor and comply with the guidance of government authorities and adjust our operations as needed. We would like to update you on how this affects your experience at AquaKids and reiterate our commitment to providing the safest and most comfortable environment possible.

Effective Wednesday 3/10/21:

- **Masks will be highly encouraged** but not mandatory. Our employees will continue to wear face masks or face shields.
- Temperature checks will be discontinued.
- Building flow - you can enter and exit through the front door. Please use care and caution for others. You may continue to exit through side/rear doors if you prefer.
- More than 1 parent/guardian per swimmer will be allowed.

If anyone in your family is experiencing any of the following symptoms, please stay home:

- Fever
- Chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath
- Difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Body aches
- Headache
- Loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea

Our make-up lesson policy has been flexible over the last year; this will continue. We will continue sanitizing efforts for high-touch surfaces, hand sanitizer will be readily available, and social distanced viewing will remain in place where possible.
